SECTION I

What I Can Do for Your Audience

I am a Philadelphia novelist and Professor Emeritus of English with more than three decades of classroom experience — undergraduate seminars, graduate workshops, secondary AP classes, and a fully funded Writing Fellowship at Exeter College, University of Oxford. I have chaired departments in both English and Social Studies. My novel *Give Them Unquiet Dreams* received a Kirkus starred review and was named a Kirkus Best Book of 2019. I founded Silver Current Press.

What I bring is a body of literature-and-craft courses for adult readers who are not looking for a degree. Every course is discussion-based, generous, close in its reading, and non-competitive. When a course lands well at a new venue, I am glad to offer the first offering without charge as a proof of concept; ongoing terms are shaped to fit the host.

SECTION IV

How I Can Deliver a Course

In person. At libraries, bookstores, community centers, universities, retirement communities, and literary nonprofits — anywhere in the Philadelphia region, and, on request, elsewhere in the Northeast.

Formats. Full sixteen-session series, four-session workshops, single evening author talks, or one-day masterclasses.

What I supply. Syllabus, discussion questions, close-reading passages, revision checklists, and — if useful — a live classroom whiteboard at whiteboard.silvercurrentpress.com for shared writing during sessions. All readings are drawn from the public domain or open-access sources; students never need to buy a book.

What the host supplies. A room and its promotion. Everything else is on my side.

How to Say Yes

The simplest way to explore a partnership is a short email — the venue, an approximate audience size, and a proposed date window. I will reply within two business days.

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
