The Art of Telling

Short story · poetry · memoir — the course that gave the salon its name

The salon's flagship course — a ten-session tour through the three great genres of narrative literature. Each session reads a short published piece, then invites participants to try the same craft at home. Designed for adults who want to read seriously and write seriously without the pressures of a workshop or the constraints of a graded class. This is the course to start with.

SIX REPRESENTATIVE SESSIONS

1. The story that fits on one page
2. The story that turns on a single moment
3. The poem that tells a story
4. The poem that refuses to
5. The memoir that shows without telling
6. The memoir that admits its shape

Full series:	Sixteen weekly sessions of 90 minutes
Workshop:	Four to eight sessions, shaped to the venue's calendar
Single talk:	One 60–90 minute lecture on a chosen theme
